• **Medical:** Diabetic testing/treatment, hypertension, eye examinations (prescription glasses), malaria, pain, dental examination, colonoscopy, prostate cancer test (PSA), breast examination, prenatal care, pap smear, wound care, cardiac tests (EKG), pediatric care, among others

- Surgical: Cataract, glaucoma, fibroid removal, among others
- Medical/Surgical Consultations

The following medical professionals/providers will be needed: General surgeons, general family practitioners, consultants, anesthetists, ophthalmologists, optometrists, dentists, pharmacists, pharmacy assistants, physical therapists, certified nurse practitioners, nurses, laboratory technicians.
